

# Study trips about Planning and Promotion of Cycling in Denmark



Our next study trip will take place in Copenhagen **June 1-3, 2026**. It starts Monday at 7pm and ends Wednesday at 5 pm.

The concept of the study trip is **extraordinary**. Bike from A to B. Hear a lecture. Bike from B to C. Have lunch. Bike from C to D. Hear another lecture. Bike from D to E. Have an evening meal. ... Go from G to H with bicycles in train. Hear yet a lecture. ...

The bike trips will take place both in central Copenhagen and in a Copenhagen suburb.

As a participant you will have access to a bicycle during the event. You will also receive a link to a specific website with general info, maps, and - after the lectures have been held - the powerpoints shown as well as other sources of relevant material.

All lecturers are experienced experts in several fields of cycling.

Participation price (year 2026) is 600 € if you register before or at the 1st May, 2026. The regular price is 680 €. The price includes all meals, bicycle rental and public transport during the study trip, but not accommodation (hotel and breakfast). An e-bike instead of a regular bike will cost 75 € extra. The early bird price can also be obtained if you register at least two participants at the same time.
